# **COVID-19 Update** Employee and Physician Information

- February 22, 2021 14 cases
  - 12 cases are in the Eastern Health region.
  - Two travelled-related cases in NL
- February 21, 2021 25 cases
  - All cases are in the Eastern Health region.
  - 1 presumptive positive case
- February 20, 2021 38 cases
  - All cases are in the Eastern Health region.
  - o 3 presumptive positive cases

- Total number cases: 940
- Active cases: 407\*
- Recovered cases: 526
- Total number in hospital: 5
- Total number deaths: 4
  - Total vaccine doses administered in NL: 16,458
    - Staff vaccinations: 3,000+

## **PPE - Personal Protective Equipment**

- We remind staff and physicians that **strict adherence to PPE guidelines** is critical to protect yourself and others. Appropriate use of PPE is one of our best defenses against the spread of COVID-19 within the health-care environment and ensures adequate staffing levels during this outbreak.
- What PPE do I need to wear? Every situation is unique. Health-care workers must use the <u>Point</u> of <u>Care Risk Assessment (PCRA)</u> to determine the appropriate PPE for each client encounter. Based on the PCRA, health-care workers will have access to the necessary PPE.

#### Masks

- While widespread community transmission is occurring, or until advised otherwise, a **face shield and mask must be worn** during **all** client encounters in all inpatient, community and residential settings, including long-term care.
- The mask and face shield must be worn for repeated interactions with multiple clients.
- Face shields must be changed in between each patient encounter for suspect or confirmed COVID-19 cases. See frequently asked questions on face shields.

• Though it is optional to wear a face shield in common areas, staff and physicians must make every effort to **always wear a mask in the workplace**, except when eating, and to observe other infection control measures. Remember that physical distancing of two metres/six feet is required in the workplace, even while on break. See mask policy.

## **Occupational Health**

- Staff and physicians should **contact Occupational Health**, at 709-777-7777, path 3-2 or email <u>occhealth@easternhealth.ca</u>, for any questions related to test results, isolation, return to work, close contacts, or similar matters.
- Occupational Health is operating extended hours, **seven days a week from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. midnight** to accommodate for the influx of inquiries.
- Employees and physicians must continue to complete the **daily COVID-19 self-assessment** before each shift. Please ensure you are using the most up-to-date screening tool, found at: <u>forms.healthenl.ca/selfassessment</u>.

## Human Resources – Staffing Levels

- We are balancing staffing needs across Eastern Health, and in between swabbing clinics and acute and long-term care sites and are limiting the movement of staff between health-care sites where possible. This work is being coordinated by an HR team dedicated to deployment and movement of staff. Please direct questions to your supervisor.
- Health workers must observe public health and infection prevention practices such as wearing appropriate PPE, frequent hand washing, following physical distancing protocols when working and on break, etc. – to limit the risk of spreading COVID-19 in the workplace and across healthcare sites.
