**RE:** Occupational Health Recommendations for Individuals Who Visited Impacted Establishments

In follow up to the [Provincial Government news release](#), which was issued today regarding impacts to various establishments, please see below recommendations from occupational health. These only apply to people who dined in or picked up orders inside the establishments. Anyone who only used the drive through would not be affected.

1. If an employee, physician, vendor and agent visited either of the establishments below, please self-isolate. You can go on-line to book a swab at <https://covidassessment.nlchi.nl.ca/> and call Occupational Health at 777-7777 pathway 3-2.
2. If someone in your household has visited either of the establishment below, they must self-isolate, and book a swab at <https://covidassessment.nlchi.nl.ca/> or call 811 as per direction from news release.
3. Employees, physicians, vendors and agents with household contact who visited the establishments (e.g., siblings or other family members) **do not** need to isolate at this time unless the household contact has symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive because of this investigation. Staff must reach out to Occupational Health at 777-7777 pathway 3 then pathway 2.
4. If an employee, physician, vendor and agent cannot isolate from the household contact that visited one of these establishments than you will have to isolate together and call Occupational Health at 777-7777 pathway 3-2 for further direction.
