- The Avalon region is now in <u>Alert Level 4</u>, while other areas of the province are in <u>Alert Level 3</u>.
- Schools K-12 resume in-class instruction this week.
- <u>New public health measures</u> are in place for rotational workers returning to the province from non-outbreak sites.
- On March 11, 2021, Eastern Health sites across the region lowered flags to half-mast to mark the National Day of Observance for COVID-19.

# **COVID-19 Vaccines**

#### Public

- COVID-19 vaccines are underway for individuals 85 and older who have pre-registered.
- We are currently booking appointments for individuals aged 70 to 84 years, who have preregistered for the COVID-19 vaccine.

#### Staff & Physicians

• Frontline health-care workers who may come into direct contact with patients/clients are prioritized for Phase 2.

- Public Health is continuing to identify eligible staff and physicians through programs.
- All remaining Eastern Health employees, who work in administrative roles and work in areas where they are not in contact with patients/clients (i.e., human resources, IT, Finance etc.), will be vaccinated in Phase 3.
- Phase 2 health-care workers will be immunized starting mid to late April.
- We ask that you do not contact the booking clerks as they are only able to book appointments for our current priority groups which include the 70 plus age group and home support workers.
- Staff and physicians are reminded that COVID-19 vaccines are not booked by Occupational Health.
