COVID-19 Vaccines

- A revised second dose vaccine schedule for all vaccines was approved for use in Canada extending the interval for the second dose of vaccine to **four months**.
- All second doses appointments currently booked for employees have been cancelled.
- Staff and physicians will be contacted at a later time with a new appointment date.

PPE Supply

- Determine appropriate PPE use through the <u>Point of Care Risk Assessment (PCRA)</u>.
- A face shield and mask must be worn during all client encounters in all inpatient, community and residential settings, including long-term care. See full recommendations.
- Daily PPE supply scorecard is now available on the <u>COVID-19 intranet: PPE Supply Chain</u>.

Masks & common spaces

- Masks should **only** be removed while eating or drinking.
- Eat only in designated eating areas, e.g. break rooms, cafeterias.
- Drink only when you are alone and can properly remove your mask.
- Maintain six feet/2 metres between staff when unmasked and while eating or drinking. Please remember, there is no such thing as a "work bubble".
- Do not remove or rearrange furniture to add more people to a table.
- All personal items, including food items, should be stored in designated areas and not in common spaces (example: nursing desks).
