## Re: COVID-19 swabbing for all staff who worked at St. Clare's Mercy Hospital from February 19-26<sup>th</sup>

As part of a site surveillance testing initiative, all staff, physicians, and students who worked at St. Clare's Mercy Hospital between February 19-26, 2021 inclusive, are required to have a COVID-19 swab. All site managers are asked to identify any employee who worked St. Clare's Mercy Hospital during this time frame.

All staff/physicians are asked to book their swab using the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador COVID-19 site: <u>https://www.811healthline.ca/covid-19-self-assessment/</u>. When completing the self-assessment, please identify yourself as a staff, physician or student who worked at St. Clare's Mercy Hospital to ensure your swab appointment is prioritized. Swab results are available on the website: <u>https://healthenl.ca/concerto/nlchi/covidresults/CovidResultsSplash.htm</u>.

Staff and physicians are permitted to work while you await your test results and must wear full contact/droplet precaution personal protection equipment (PPE) during all patient encounters. This should be changed between each patient interaction. Full contact/droplet precaution PPE includes:

- mask;
- face shield;
- gown;
- gloves.

**PLEASE NOTE:** In all common areas, including offices, unit group areas, hallways etc. required PPE includes:

- full face shields, and
- masks.

In all cases, social distancing of two metres or more must be maintained and appropriate hand hygiene must be practiced.

As this is site testing only, staff will **NOT** be required to receive clearance from Occupational Health. Those who tested positive only will be contacted by Occupational Health for further direction.

While waiting for results, all staff/physicians and students are expected to isolate from their families. If you are unable to isolate at home or require hotel services, please contact the Navigator Line at **(709) 752-3663**.

Managers are asked to provide the spreadsheet attached to identify all employees in your program/services areas who worked at St. Clare's Mercy Hospital from February 19 to 26 and return the spreadsheet to St. Clare's Mercy Hospital EOC as soon as possible.
