



# Memo from the Vice President

April 5, 2021

To: All Eastern Health Staff, Physicians, Students and Medical Residents

Re: Vaccination Campaign for Phase Two

This is to provide further information on the vaccination campaign for phase two (2) health care workers.

We have now received names of over 4000 employees who are working in areas of the Organization that are considered priority to be offered vaccine in phase two of the campaign in accordance with the provincial schedule. These include employees who are working in direct care areas such as inpatient units, community clinics, and public areas within our facilities and who are otherwise unable to work from home during this timeframe.

In the email below you will find a URL and a Code that can be used by you to book an appointment online through Pomelo, the online provincial appointment portal. Please note that the URL and Code will not be activated until midnight April 5<sup>th</sup>. This is necessary to ensure that all of the clinics below are posted and available for booking.

We know that many of you have been waiting a long time to be called for your vaccine. We appreciate your patience as we have worked hard to ensure our highest risk populations (such as seniors in congregate living environments) and staff and physicians on the front lines of the pandemic response are safely vaccinated.

You are only permitted to book into one of the clinics identified below. Please <u>DO NOT</u> attempt to book into other clinics as they are reserved for other priority groups.

### Before your appointment:

1. If you are immunosuppressed (i.e., have a weakened immune system), or have an autoimmune condition (such as Crohn's disease, MS, or Rheumatoid Arthritis) you are encouraged to speak to your health care provider prior to your appointment to discuss the potential risk and benefits of receiving the COVID-19 Vaccine. However, please still book your appointment. You do NOT need a note from your health care provider to receive the vaccine.
