IPAC & Workplace Safety

- Mask compliance is mandatory in all health-care facilities.
- Health workers in shared workspaces must continue to always wear masks (even if spaced six feet apart).
- Masks must be worn at all times, with the exception of when eating or drinking.
 - Eat only in designated eating areas, e.g., break rooms, cafeterias.
 - Drink only when you are alone and can properly remove your mask.
 - Keep a distance of six feet between staff when eating/drinking and when unmasked.
 - There is no such thing as a "work bubble."
- Meetings should happen virtually whenever possible.
- If in-person meetings are essential, masks and social distancing are mandatory.

COVID-19 Vaccines

- We continue to vaccinate residents ages 65 years and older.
 - People should continue to check the booking website as clinics are added weekly at https://portal.healthmyself.net/nleasternhealth/forms/XMO.

- The AstraZeneca vaccination clinics for individuals 55 to 64, which opened earlier this week, are now full.
- As we continue to move through priority groups, we will be moving to open calls, meaning there will be no more pre-registration.
- We are reaching out to individuals who work in the dental community to book their vaccines.

 Vaccination clinics for clinically vulnerable populations and rotational workers will open in the coming days.
