Re: Eastern Health Employees Can Book COVID-19 Vaccinations through Pomelo Website

In keeping with Phase 2 of the Provincial Immunization Plan, COVID-19 vaccines are now available for all health-care workers who may come into direct contact with patients. This includes private health-care workers (e.g., chiropractors, massage therapists, physiotherapists, psychologists, etc.). Eastern Health employees, including students/residents who may come into direct contact with patients, may now also book appointments through the Pomelo web site. Eastern Health staff, who do not qualify for vaccines under phase 1 or 2 of the immunization plan, have the option to book into an AstraZeneca clinic if they are between the ages of 55 and 64. In addition, these employees will be invited to book an appointment when phase 3 is announced.

Any eligible Eastern Health employee who fits into phase 2, as noted above, and has not yet booked their vaccine can book an appointment at one of the available clinics using the steps below:

- Complete the eligibility questionnaire and consent.
- Select and book a vaccine appointment at their preferred clinic location.

Given this change, staff will no longer need to book their vaccine appointments through Occupational Health which is an improved process.
