Update from CEO and Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) June 17, 2021

General update

- There was 1 new person diagnosed with COVID-19 in the province today, in the Central Health region. Please see pandemic hub for up to date information <u>here</u>.
- On Friday, June 11, it was announced that the communities of St. George's, Stephenville Crossing, Stephenville, Port au Port East and all towns on the Port au Port Peninsula and towns and communities along Routes 403, 460, 461, 462, 463 and 490 were moving to Alert Level 2 at midnight.
- More than 200 COVID-19 tests were completed in the Piccadilly area last week and Public Health did not find there was widespread transmission in the community. All individuals who were identified as positive have been the contact of a case; however, the initial source remains under investigation.
- The Chief Medical Officer of Health announced yesterday that all appointments for second doses of COVID-19 vaccines scheduled after August 6, 2021, would be cancelled and individuals would need to reschedule their second appointment earlier. All second dose appointments can now be rescheduled at a minimum of 8 weeks after the first dose. While there are some appointments currently available for second doses, additional appointments will be available for booking starting on Monday, June 21, 2021. Read more here.

Operations Update

- While all of the region is in Alert Level 2, enhanced PPE requirements are still in effect. All health care workers are required to wear a mask and eye protection for all client/patient/resident encounters. Evidence is being reviewed on a regular basis and when there is an update, further information will be shared.
- Thank you to everyone for continuing to complete PPE audits using the <u>electronic tool</u>. In May, 784 audits were completed, and results indicate that employees are compliant with wearing PPE 95% of the time. We encourage everyone to continue to complete these audits.
- As we plan for the reopening the province to travel throughout the Atlantic provinces on June 23, we anticipate there will be changes to the current COVID-19 screening tools. We will communicate any changes as it becomes available.
