- Total number cases: 1,570
- Active cases: 46\*
- Recovered cases: 1,510
- Total number deaths: 7

- Total vaccine doses administered in NL: 802,647 (as of September 16, 2021).
- # health-care workers (HCW) vaccinated in the Eastern Health region (as of September 16, 2021):

#### COVID-19 Vaccines

- Eastern Health continues to support the scientific, evidence-based approach and advice of the World Health Organization (WHO), the Public Health Agency of Canada (PHAC), Health Canada, the National Advisory Committee on Immunization (NACI), and the Chief Medical Officer of Health in regard to the safety and effectiveness of vaccination against COVID-19.
- Third COVID-19 Vaccine Dose (Moderately to Severely Immunocompromised Individuals):
   Eastern Health is now offering a third COVID-19 vaccine dose to individuals who are moderately to severely immunocompromised, including those receiving immunosuppressive therapies who

- may have a lower immune response to COVID-19 vaccines compared to the general population. **More information:** PSA (September 16).

### **Eastern Health Masking Requirements**

#### **Staff and Physicians**

- Masking continues to be mandatory within <u>all</u> Eastern Health facilities as well as outside of facilities while working for Eastern Health.
- As per provincial regulations, masking has continued to remain mandatory within congregate living facilities for seniors.
- Regardless of vaccination status, mask compliance continues to be mandatory for all Eastern
  Health employees, physicians and volunteers while working in an Eastern Health facility, or
  while working for the organization outside of an Eastern Health site/facility.
- Wearing masks is one of the key strategies in preventing the spread of infection, and is
  especially critical within health-care settings to protect patients, clients and residents as the
  COVID-19 pandemic evolves. More information: <u>COVID-19 intranet</u>.
- Mask compliance audit: Staff should continue to conduct visual audits on mask compliance
  within Eastern Health facilities and to complete the online survey based upon what they have
  observed during their workday. Each area/unit is expected to complete a minimum of one audit

#### **Visitor Masking Requirements**

- Reminder to visitors: Masks continue to be mandatory at all Eastern Health facilities, sites and clinics; during home visits from Eastern Health staff; as well as in congregate living facilities for seniors and within personal care homes and long-term care facilities.
- The provided mask must be worn throughout the duration of the visitor's time in our hospitals and other health-care facilities, including while visiting patient/resident rooms.

#### **Visitor Guidelines**

#### **Visitor Guidelines**

- Two adults (18+) may visit a patient at the same time, which is in accordance with Eastern Health's existing visiting policy. To comply with physical distancing requirements, the support person is included as one of the two visitors during visiting hours.
  - Visitors are not limited to one visit a day.
- All visitors/support persons are required to adhere to public health guidance at healthcare facilities to ensure the safety of patients/residents and staff.
- Some areas across the organization may not be able to accommodate multiple support
  people/visitors due to physical distancing requirements. In these cases, care teams will work
  with families to identify visitation options.

#### **Support persons (Out-patient Appointments)**

- To assist with physical distancing for out-patient visits, patients are asked to proceed to their
  appointment unaccompanied if they can safely do so without assistance/support from a support
  person.
- Patients who require assistance/support are permitted to have one support person accompany
  them to outpatient appointments. The clinical care team will accommodate one support person
  in the treatment area when requested by the patient and if sufficient space is available to do so
  safely.

### **Visitor Restrictions Update**

- Caribou Memorial Veterans Pavilion: Visitor restrictions have been lifted and general visitation is now open at unit 2 South at Caribou Memorial Veterans Pavilion. Visitor restrictions were <u>originally implemented on September 9</u> following a case of COVID-19 identified in the Eastern Health region. General visitation opened to the remainder of the facility on September 13, 2021.

### **Infection Prevention and Control & Workplace Safety**

- Please keep in mind the following:
  - o Eat only in designated eating areas, e.g., break rooms, cafeterias.
  - o Drink only when you are alone and can properly remove your mask.
  - Keep a distance of six feet between staff when eating/drinking and when unmasked.
- Meetings should continue to happen virtually whenever possible.
- If in-person meetings are required, masks may be removed while seated and physical distance maintained. Masks are required when moving around the room.
