Update from CEO and Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) September 23, 2021

General update

- In yesterday's provincial public advisory, there were 23 new individuals diagnosed with COVID-19:
 - 21 in the Central Health region
 - 2 in the Western Health region. Read more <u>here</u>.
 - The total number of active cases in the Western region is 3.

- Last week Western Health announced that third doses of COVID-19 vaccines are available for immunocompromised individuals, who may have a lower immune response to COVID-19 vaccines compared to the general population. Read more here.

Operations Update

- 75.8% of the eligible population of the Western Heath region have received two doses of COVID-19 vaccine, and 83.3% have had at least one dose (as of September 22).
- Vaccination is encouraged for everyone 12 years of age and older. Walk-in and booked appointments are available throughout the region at public health vaccine clinics. Please book online here or call 1-833-703-5470. Vaccines are also available at participating pharmacies and physicians' offices.
- With increased respiratory infections in the region, IPAC is strongly recommending staff wear mask and eye protection during exposure to patients with suspected influenza like illness (ILI) or severe acute respiratory infection (SARI). Read more here.
- Community transmission of COVID-19 has been identified on the Baie Verte peninsula (in Central Health region). Individuals from the Baie Verte peninsula who visit Western Health facilities will now answer "yes" on our COVID-19 screening tool question referencing "widespread community transmission." Please follow isolation and testing requirements as per the appropriate screening tool for visitors or patients/clients/residents. Read more here.
