
COVID-19 Update Employee and Physician Information



Update from CEO and Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) January 14, 2022

General update

- In today's provincial public advisory, there were 475 individuals diagnosed with COVID-19, 39 in the Western Health region, 350 in the Eastern Health region, 26 in the Central Health region and 51 in the Labrador-Grenfell Health region. There are also nine individuals whose tests were completed at a private lab outside an RHA (read more here). See pandemic hub here.
- Over the last week our demand for staffing exploded given the impact of Omicron and staff requiring isolation. Many of you volunteered and were redeployed to help areas in greatest need. Once again you stepped up and we owe you a huge debt of gratitude. We are so appreciative of everyone who continues to go above and beyond to support their colleagues and the patients, clients, residents of Western Health. THANK YOU!
- We also need to thank you all for following all the guidelines to help reduce the spread, including wearing appropriate PPE, physical distancing and staggering breaks/eating alone. Your efforts are making a difference. With everyone doing their part to help, we are beginning to see less workplace exposures and a decline in the numbers of staff members diagnosed with COVID-19.
- As staffing levels start to stabilize, we will be working with our redeployment team to
 explore options for flexibility in terms of annual leave and days owed. We ask for your
 continued patience during this process as we balance staffing demand at all our facilities
 in the region, with meeting the needs of all our clients, patients and residents.

Operations Update

• 81.7% of the eligible population (aged 5+) of the Western Heath region have received two doses of COVID-19 vaccine, and 90 % have had at least one dose (as of January 13). These statistics now include 5-11 year olds as part of the eligible population. So far 60.9 % of 5-11 year olds in the Western region have had their first dose. In addition, 28.8 % of all eligible individuals have received a booster dose.
