Re: UPDATED - IPAC Guidance for Omicron Variant of Concern

The Omicron variant of SARS-CoV2 is presenting significant challenges in Eastern Health due to its increased transmissibility. As such, IPAC recommends the following effective immediately:

AGMPs:

 A fit-tested N95 Respirator is required for all aerosol generating medical procedures, regardless of COVID-19 test or screening result. Pre-procedure testing and AGMP admission testing are no longer required.

PPE Requirements:

Any Health Care Worker (HCW) with direct care of patients/residents/clients with confirmed COVID-19 or symptoms and/or exposure to a confirmed case wear:

- N95 Respirator
- Face shield
- Gowns
- Gloves

For all patient/resident/client interactions wear:

- Continuous masking with a well fitted mask
- Face shield

On outbreak unit(s) wear:

- N95 Respirator at all times
- Face shield at all times

All healthcare workers are advised to continue using their <u>Point of Care Risk Assessment</u> (PCRA) to determine the appropriate PPE for that encounter. Based on the PCRA, healthcare workers shall have access to the appropriate PPE. This will not be unreasonably denied by their employer.

Patient/Residents/Client Masking and Distancing:

- All patients/residents in shared accommodations should have curtains pulled and distancing maintained.
- If patient/resident/client able to do so, instruct them to wear a mask when leaving their bedspace and when within 6 feet of others, including staff.

Patient/Resident/Client Monitoring and Testing Regime of identified close contacts:

- Continue to monitor all patients/residents/clients for signs/symptoms of COVID-19 daily and if identified, test and isolate.
- For inpatients/residents/clients that are identified as close contacts of a confirmed COVID-19 case:
 - 1. Test 72 hours post-exposure
 - 2. Test 7 days post-exposure
 - 3. Test if symptoms develop at any point during the 14-day isolation period
- If transmission is detected in outbreak areas, increasing the testing frequency may be recommended.
