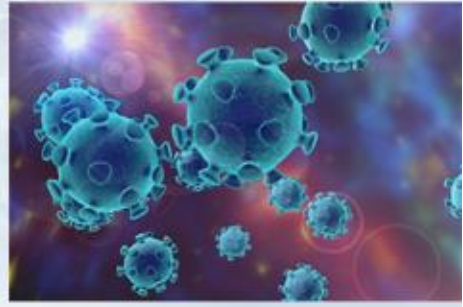

Re: Update on COVID-19 Protocols in Eastern Health Facilities

As the COVID-19 pandemic continues, it is important to remember we must all remain vigilant in our daily activities to maximize the safety of staff and clients. However, as levels of COVID-19 infection in the province have decreased in recent months, Eastern Health is making changes to our capacity guidelines in public spaces, meeting spaces and staff break rooms.

Effective today, Monday, July 11, 2022, capacity limits in break rooms, cafeterias and meeting rooms will be increased. Additionally, break room spaces, added to units as a result of COVID-19, will be removed and return to their original purposes. Every effort should be made to continue physical distancing of at least six feet where possible.

Masking will continue to be mandatory at all sites throughout the region in all clinical, administrative and non-clinical areas. Masks may only be removed in designated eating areas or when alone in an office space.

The past two years have been long and difficult; we thank you for your continued hard work and perseverance.
